

Euro Suspension Team Candidate:

“What is Euro Suspension Team (EST) going to do for me?” This letter will give a detailed list of what is expected from the rider, the parent and myself, the team owner.

I would like to introduce myself. I am Frank Bartolotta and I have been participating in motocross for 25 years. I am the owner/operator of Euro Raceway in Nashville, Illinois.

I have been doing bike suspensions since 1998. I take great pride in my suspension set-up and have completed over 200 suspensions for local and national riders in the last 10 years.

I will travel with the team to each event and also be an active rider. I will provide support in help with bike maintenance and suspension upkeep. I will also provide positive encouragement for morale and moral conduct.

The EST is a new organization. There will be a board of directors consisting of officers: president, vice-president and secretary/treasurer. The board will be comprised of team members and will preside over meetings which you are encouraged to attend in order to be updated of current events. The board will also be responsible for recruiting new riders.

Board members will be actively searching for sponsors for the team. As EST acquires sponsors, team members will share in the sponsorship. Eventually, I would like to have all team members outfitted with gear from our sponsors, plastics on the bikes provided and entry fees paid by them. If you know of some organization, business or person that would be interested in being a sponsor, please contact a board member or myself and we will do the follow up. Whether they be small or big, they will be approached as a positive asset to our team.

- Be responsible for set up of your bike at each racing event.

What does EST expect from the parents?

- Good sportsmanship on and off the track.
- Positive encouragement of your participant.
- Getting your rider to scheduled training with EST.
- Travel with EST to scheduled events
- Help at Euro Raceway events; before, during and after.

The key part of being an EST team member is to have EURO SUSPENSION ON YOUR BIKE. You will not be considered for a team rider position, unless you have Euro Suspension.
